Community Health Services


The Community Health Services unit of **JKYT** was established in 2022 with a mission to bring preventive and promotive health services directly to the community. This initiative focuses on improving health awareness and providing basic health services to underserved populations.

These services include:

1. **Free health check-ups for school children** conducted at their respective school premises
2. **Geriatric health check-ups** for senior citizens
3. **Health education sessions** focused on **oral health awareness**
4. **Awareness camps** promoting the benefits of **Yoga and Naturopathy**



Health Education



Medical Screening Programme

As part of the **Medical Check-up Programme for Students (2024-2025)**, a total of **1,272 students** from 5 different schools were screened under the Community Health Services Unit of JKYT. The participating schools included:

JNV – 531 students

Nigamananda Govt High School – 137 students

Gavalabanka – 229 students

Ratagarh – 72 students

Adarsh Bidyalaya, Orilo – 303 students

After obtaining permission from the school and informing the **Chief District Medical Officer/Government authorities**, a team comprising doctors and paramedical staff visits the school for medical screening and submit the reports to the Principal/Headmaster.

- In a heartwarming initiative to promote health and wellness, Jivan Jagruti Welfare Trust, in collaboration with ASG Eye Hospital and Jagadguru Kripalu Yog Trust, organised a **Free Geriatric Health Awareness Program** at the JKYT campus. The event, held on September 1st, 2024, offered a unique blend of valuable health services, educational sessions, and engaging activities, all aimed at improving the quality of life for senior citizens.

Free eye check-ups: *Eye care specialists from ASG Eye Hospital provided free checkups for various eye conditions, including Cataracts, Corneal issues, Lasik, Retina problems, Glaucoma, and Eye Trauma. These services were crucial in helping attendees maintain their vision and overall eye health, which often deteriorates with age.*

- **(Bone Mineral Density) BMD tests:** *A critical tool in assessing bone health and preventing osteoporosis.*
- **Muscle strength assessments:** *Offering insights into muscle functionality, vital for preserving mobility and independence in later years.*
- **Education on managing age-related health issues:** *Experts shared insights on managing and preventing age-related conditions. The geriatric physiotherapy exercises session was particularly popular, providing practical advice on maintaining strength and flexibility as one ages. These sessions educated and empowered participants, equipping them with the knowledge needed to take control of their health. The atmosphere was learning and camaraderie as participants engaged in discussions and shared their health journeys.*

Jagadguru Kripalu Chikitsalay (JKC) is a multidisciplinary polyclinic located within the campus of **Jagadguru Kripalu Yog Trust (JKYT)**. It offers a range of outpatient services across departments including **General Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, Obstetrics & Gynecology, and Dental care**.

The clinic is supported by a well-equipped **diagnostic laboratory**, along with facilities for **X-ray, ultrasound, and ECG**. Additional support services include a **dressing room, ambulance service**, and an in-house **pharmacy**.

Specialist doctors in **Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics, and Dentistry** regularly visit the clinic, ensuring expert consultation and care. All medical services are delivered by a team of **qualified and dedicated healthcare professionals**.

JKC is committed to providing **high-quality medical care at an affordable cost**. Notably, there are **no charges for registration or consultation**, and patients receive a 10% discount on medicines. Charges for investigations and procedures are applied as per **CGHS (Central Government Health Scheme) rates**, ensuring transparency and affordability.

SCHOOL BAG DISTRIBUTION

2-Month Agriculture Extension Service Provider Internship Program (17th January 2025)

- JKYog Natural Foods and Agro Pvt. Ltd., in collaboration with PMKVY Skill Hub 4.0 (Government of India), marked the successful completion of the two-month Agriculture Extension Service Provider Internship Program. Held at the JKU Campus, this event showcased the convergence of innovation, knowledge, and practical application in agriculture.
- Students from C V Raman Global University** and JKU gathered to explore cutting-edge agricultural techniques focusing on enhancing paddy cultivation. The program equipped them with the skills to implement innovative practices in real-world farming scenarios.





- The Jagadguru Kripalu Skill Institute (JKSI) conducted the Final Assessment/Examination on **20 December 2024** for 52 BSc Agriculture candidates from CV Raman Global University. These students had been part of a two-month Agri Extension Service Provider Skill training program at JKSI. The Skill Ministry of India supported the program and sent two examiners to oversee the assessment.

The training sessions were effectively designed to instil the concepts and methodologies of solar food processing.



- JKSI has successfully facilitated placement offers for 42 out of the 52 candidates in two agri – corporates. Additionally, three more campus interviews were held after the results were announced.



- This inaugural residential program aimed to provide agriculture students with practical skills and industry insights. By integrating theoretical knowledge with hands-on training, it seeks to prepare students for industry requirements.

- After 2-months intensive training, certificates acknowledging their hard work and commitment to agricultural development were distributed to 51 BSc (Hons.) Agriculture students.
- As India continues to make strides in agricultural innovation, programs like these are essential in empowering young minds to take on leadership roles in this crucial industry. With the backing of PMKVY Skill Hub 4.0 and esteemed academic institutions like JKU and C V Raman Global University, the future of agriculture looks brighter than ever.


